**Breath Test Operator Basic Class, Breath Test / SFST Refresher Classes, ARIDE, DUI Detection and SFST Basic & GREEN LAB.**

## **Breath Test OPERATOR BASIC Class:**

You must attend this class if your Breath Test Permit Card is expired more than 90 days. This is an up to 16-hour training class but will be taught to standard and not to time, in one day.

## **Breath Test REFRESHER Class:**

You should attend this 4-hour class if your Breath Test Permit Card has yet to expire or is less than 90 days past expiration. If you go past the 90-day grace period, you will need to attend the Breath Test OPERATOR BASIC class to comply.

## **SFST REFRESHER Class:**

This class is offered in conjunction with the Breath Test REFRESHER Class and provides a strong review of the DUI investigation basics. The class should provide officers the confidence needed to make the appropriate Impaired Driving arrest decisions.

## **ARIDE:**

An introduction to DRUGS that impair driving; builds confidence in the application and assessment of the SFSTs and introduces officers to the signs and symptoms drugs will exhibit when consumed. This class is a requirement prior to attending DRE School and to work TZT HVE DUI Emphasis shifts. Highly encouraged for all patrol officers and especially FTOs.

## **DUI DETECTION & SFST CLASS:**

Refresh your Impaired Driving investigation knowledge and gain CONFIDENCE on how to detect, evaluate and process those arrests from start to finish. This class will refresh your proficiency in the application and assessment of the SFSTs and includes a practical application wet lab on the final day.

## **GREEN LAB:**

This training is a combination of classroom and practical application of the SFST's in a controlled environment. There will be in-depth classroom instruction covering the who, what, where, why and how of Cannabis. Then you will have an opportunity to interact and ask questions of the consumers before, during and after they consume, to include conducting the SFST's, so you can better recognize the signs and symptoms of impairment you may have overlooked on previous driver interactions.
