Dear Ms. Loginsky:

This letter serves as an update to the notification provided by the WSP Toxicology Laboratory Division on March 11, 2021. The laboratory contracted with BioClean to perform follow-up environmental testing of areas used in sample preparation during extraction of amines batch 201216AS. BioClean performed sampling of 11 areas on 3/16/21 and the laboratory has received the report with analytical results from sample testing.

Areas sampled were non-detected for methamphetamine residue, with the exception of sample area #7, which had residue detected, but results below the Washington state guideline for clean-up.

In addition, members of the Forensic Investigations Council (FIC) have begun efforts to form a group of stakeholders to provide additional resources in support of the laboratory's efforts to address the environmental contamination.
