WSP Seeking Witnesses To A Road Rage Incident Involving Shots Fired

King County: At approximately 6:12am on April 18, 2018, the Washington State Patrol (WSP) received a 911 call from an individual stating he had just been shot while driving his car NB I-5 in the area of Michigan St. The subject stated he had a gunshot wound to his leg and was driving himself to Harborview Medical Center.

Trooper Webb along with detectives arrived at Harborview to speak with the victim. The victim stated that this all started somewhere in the area of NB I-5 near the Boeing Access exit when another passenger vehicle cut in front of him and slammed on the brakes. This continued until just before Michigan St. when the suspect vehicle pulled to the left of the victim, rolled down the passenger window and fire two shots into his vehicle, one of which struck him in the left leg. The suspect vehicle exited to Michigan St. and the victim continued NB I-5 and drove to Harborview. The victim was released later that day.

The victim described the suspect vehicle as a dark gray or teal Toyota passenger vehicle with two Seahawk stickers on the side of the vehicle. The description of the driver was a black male wearing a black jacket and beanie cap. The victim vehicle is a purple Honda Accord shown below.
