Homeland Security Division: Winter weather reminder

Seattle – The Washington State Patrol Homeland Security Division would like to remind all drivers and passengers across the Washington State Ferry (WSF) system that the changing weather and lower temperatures allow for slick roadways leading to and surrounding the WSF terminals. It is important to continue to watch your speed throughout the WSF terminals and be mindful of metal grating and other potentially slick transition surfaces throughout the area. With the days getting shorter, more travel will occur during the hours of darkness. Please watch for pedestrians, bicyclists and other motorists.

Vessel and Terminal Security troopers will continue to enforce speed and other driving violations in and around the ferry terminals and roadways leading into the area. The Washington State Patrol Homeland Security Division has and will continue to support the Target Zero goal in order to help the state get to zero traffic fatalities by the year 2030.

Please, continue to alert WSP troopers in person or by calling 911 if dangerous driving is occurring in and around WSF terminals and surrounding roadways. WSP troopers will continue to work diligently to ensure passengers have a safe commute to and from the WSF terminals as well as aboard the vessels.
