Subject of possible rule making: Ignition interlock device security and unlock codes

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 43.43.395, 46.37.005, 46.04.215

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Ignition interlock technology has advanced significantly in recent years to accommodate a secure and reliable method of remotely unlocking ignition interlock devices during a lockout condition. This rule would allow ignition interlock manufacturers to utilize this technology while, at the same time, creating a secure and accountable method of testing and oversight of any use by the Washington State Patrol.
