

Equipment List for 40th Cadet Arming Class

- A minimum of six white crew neck T-shirts (100% cotton)
- A minimum of six pair of black uniform socks (no logos)
- A minimum of six pair of white athletic socks
- Good quality running-type shoes
- Wrestling shoes
- Appropriate protective athletic apparel (gender specific)
- Form-fitting mouth piece (purchased at a local athletic supply outlet)
- Cadets should be prepared to purchase physical fitness clothing and a WSP water bottle during their first day at the Academy from the Memorial Foundation for \$180 (**cash only**)
- Long sleeve, navy blue rash-guard compression/protective shirt for control tactics to be worn under their purchased physical fitness shirt
- Compression style shorts (long) to be worn under workout shorts
- Personal toiletry articles (including soap, sufficient matching towels and washcloths)
 - Four white bath towels to be used in wall locker display drawers
- Shower sandals
- 8GB or larger USB-style flash drive for document/presentation storage
- A timepiece of reasonable accuracy, second hand recommended
- Boxer-type swimming trunks (males); conservative one-piece swimming suit (females) and goggles
- Any necessary prescription medication or nonprescription over-the-counter medication, (i.e., aspirin, cold medications, etc.)
- Money for soft drink/vending machines
- Twelve white, hard plastic clothes hangers
- Three black, 3" three-ring binders, subject dividers, pencils, black ink pens, paper, and note-taking materials
- 1 - 5x7 picture frame with personal photo
- Brass cleaner (Brasso, Neverdull, Mothers, Flitz, etc.)
- Boot polishing kit (Kiwi or Lincoln, etc.)
- Edge dressing for shoes, matte & gloss finish (Angelus, Kiwi, etc.)
- Spray starch
- 2 pairs of Shirt Stays

Cadets may bring their personally owned computer (laptop) and printer; however, these are optional and NOT a required item.

NOTE:

Watching television is limited to news broadcasts between five and seven p.m. No other television viewing is allowed without prior staff permission.

- Cadets will not use personal stereo, laptop computer, or portable DVD player to watch movies or television shows, without prior supervisory approval.
- Cadets shall have a small alarm clock on their bookshelves, but are not allowed to use the radio if so equipped unless permission granted by an Academy supervisor.
- Cadets are prohibited from playing cards, pool, or other games.
