WSP Seeking Witnesses To A Pellet Gun Shooting On I-5

King County: At 9:50am this morning Washington State Patrol (WSP) communications received a 9-1-1 call from a driver reporting that their vehicle was shot at on NB I-5 near S. 200th St.

Once troopers arrived the victim driver explained that a Silver Chevrolet Equinox was tailgating them NB I-5 near S. 200th and then pulled along the passenger side of their vehicle and shot what appeared to be a handgun. The right rear passenger window was blown out and thankfully the victim did not sustain any injuries. The victim's vehicle was a white Mazda CX5.

The suspect in the Equinox was described by the victim as an African American female with braided hair. The suspect fled at a high rate after shooting at the victim.

Further investigation at the scene led investigators to believe that the gun fired was a pellet gun due to the indents on the victim vehicle.
