Detectives Seeking Information On A Carjacking/Robbery

UPDATE : The vehicle was found abandoned in Federal Way the afternoon.

King County: Washington State Patrol Detectives are investigating a carjacking / robbery which occurred November 12, 2022, at about 8:15 p.m. on NB I-5 near 288th St. in Kent. An unknown suspect was in a white passenger car when he struck a vehicle in the HOV lane and lost control veering across all lanes causing a four car collision. One of the vehicles involved was a 2002 Subaru Legacy. The suspect exited his vehicle, stolen out of Lakewood, and contacted the 74 year old female driver of the Subaru. She unlocked the door because she thought he was approaching to help her. Instead he physically pulled her from her vehicle and pushed her towards traffic. The suspect then entered her vehicle and fled the scene. The license plate on the Subaru is Washington 548 NWA.
