

Fire Instructor I Pre-Course Prep

**The following items and per-course prep work must be completed prior to class and brought with you on Day 1 of class. Failure to complete each item may result in dismissal from the class.

Required Items and Pre-Course Prep Work Prior to Class:

- Read Chapters 1-10. These chapters cover all of Fire Instructor 1. The rest of the book is for Fire Instructor 2 & 3.
- Choose a topic you want to teach come IFSAC test day. The topic you choose will need to include a hands-on portion with a skill sheet. Keep this in mind as that hands-on portion will need to be done in a classroom setting. The FTA will not be providing you with materials for the hands-on. You will have access to a computer for a PowerPoint or the Whiteboard. All other materials for your presentation you will need to bring.
- If creating a PowerPoint presentation, it needs to be less than 10 slides.
- Your presentation should only be 15-20 minutes long. This includes the lecture and practical portion.

***NOTE:** Not everyone can do how to tie a knot. You will be each other's students come test day. Get creative and be passionate about what you want to teach. Your subject can be Fire or EMS.
