

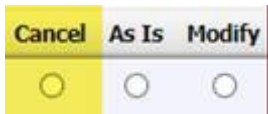

Subject: CJIS Validations - Extreme Risk Protection Orders (ERPO) Issue Identified

Hi TACs,

We recently discovered Extreme Risk Protection Order (ERPO) records are not updating NCIC when validated in [CJIS Validations](#). September 2023 was the first month there were ERPO records to be validated. There are about 200 ERPO records to be validated for September 2023.

What is the impact?

The only impact is if you select “cancel” within CJIS Validations for ERPO records only. All other records are *not* impacted.



What does this mean?

Until this issue is fixed please use Omnix or your regional system if you need to cancel an ERPO record. Your agency should still conduct and document ERPO records as applicable. For more information on validation efforts please refer to the [ACCESS Operations Manual – Chapter 1 Introduction](#).

What should I do for my ERPO records in CJIS Validations?

For ERPO records select “as is” within CJIS Validations. The records will get stuck in pending because CJIS Validations at this time is not updating NCIC for ERPO records.

When will this be fixed?

Our vendor is working on this issue and targeting getting this resolved for next month’s validations.

What do I do if I have already validated an ERPO record in CJIS Validations?

Only one agency has validated one ERPO record in CJIS Validations so far. I will reach out to that agency.
