Subject: Informational Email on Behalf of the WSP Security Team

This email is being sent to TAC's and IT POC's on behalf of the Washington State Patrol's Security Team. This is an informational email. Your agency *does not* need to respond to WSP.

The Washington State Patrol's Security Team has identified phishing attempts with emails sent to WSP employees. These emails contain email chains that were sent out to ACCESS customers. The specific instance being the subject line: RE: W3/ACCESS Updates – December 29, 2021.

The email contains the original message, then has a generic message at the top regarding downloading a file or a link to follow for clarification/files. These files and/or links contain malware. It is our Security Team's opinion that a customer subscribed to the ACCESS list serve has likely had their email account breached. We *recommend* that everyone that received the subject email verify with their IT Team that no unusual activity or logins have occurred with their account.
