Subject: Identity Theft File Converting to NIEM XML Hello,

Hello,

We will be converting the Identity Theft File to NIEM XML on October 17, 2023 between 8:00AM-9:00AM.

What is happening?

The Identity Theft File will be converted to NIEM XML. Users will not notice a difference. The following Message Keys (MKE's) will be converted:

- QIT (NCIC QID) – Query
- EIT (NCIC EID/EIDC) – Entry
- EIN – Enter Supplemental
- MIT (NCIC MID) – Modify
- XIT (NCIC XID) – Cancel
- XIN – Cancel Supplemental

Will there be a downtime?

There will not be a downtime, however there may be a slight delay in Identity Theft File responses during this time.

What do I need to do?

Your agency does not need to do anything. A few vendors/agencies have tested and confirmed functionality.
