Subject: Unidentified Person File Converting to NIEM XML

Hello,

We will be converting the Unidentified Person File to NIEM XML on November 16, 2023, between 7:00AM-8:00AM.

What is happening?

The Unidentified Person File will be converted to NIEM XML. Users will not notice a difference. The following Message Keys (MKE's) will be converted:

- QU – Query
- EU (inclusive of EUD,EUL,EUV) – Entry
- EUN – Enter Supplemental
- MU – Modify
- CU – Clear
- XU – Cancel
- XUN – Cancel Supplemental

Will there be a downtime?

There will not be a downtime, however there may be a slight delay in Unidentified Person File responses during this time.

What do I need to do?

Your agency does not need to do anything. A few vendors/agencies have tested and confirmed functionality.
