Good morning!

A quick update to let everyone know of a couple new features in SAFE this morning!

1. You now have the ability to remove a firearm after you hit submit...but, before you enter the transfer date. You'll see a large "Remove Firearm" button on each firearm listed. This ONLY works for background checks with more than one firearm.

2. There are now 'tool tips' available for each status type, giving you the description of what each status means when you hover over it.

Also, we have received several calls from FFLs who have discovered that their SAFE accounts have been deactivated.

This is by design because we need to ensure only valid accounts have access to SAFE, and SAFE gives a 30 day count down when nearing expiration as a reminder so there are no surprises.

Deactivation happens when these two criteria are met:

* The state firearm dealer license shows expired in the DOL database

AND

* The FFL has not submitted any checks for 30 days or more.

But, we are very aware that there are times when an FFL will have a valid (non-expired) state firearm dealer license, but the record at DOL has not been updated and will still show expired. When this happens (even before deactivation during the 30 day count down), please email a picture of your state firearm dealer license to firearms@wsp.wa.gov <<mailto:firearms@wsp.wa.gov>> and we will override the expiration lockout until the database is updated with the correct expiration date.
