## FIRE CONTROL I OPEN ENROLLMENT

This program introduces new firefighters to fire behavior and development, as well as water application principles to effectively extinguish Class A fires. This program provides firefighters with the skills necessary to function as the nozzle operator of an interior fire attack team. Firefighters will work in a variety of fire situations utilizing direct, indirect, and combination water application techniques.

#### PREREQUISITES:

- Meet NFPA 1403 (6.1.1) firefighter performance requirements or have Firefighter I level IFSAC certification.
- Sponsored by a fire service agency and/or enrolled in a fire service educational program.

##### OPTION 1:
