WSU LIVE FIRE INSTRUCTOR OPEN ENROLLMENT COURSE 4 HOURS

This course provides in-depth knowledge of NFPA 1403 principles and the Fire Training Academy's Live Fire Policy. Students will gain a comprehensive understanding of the Fire Training Academy's procedures for conducting safe live fire training. Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to define the guidelines for conducting live fire events at the Fire Training Academy and describe the NFPA 1403 requirements that affect live fire training, while identifying any associated legal requirements.

REGISTRATION:

CERTIFICATION:

- Fire Instructor I is no longer required for this certification, though it is recommended.
- You will **NOT** receive a certificate via the course. As long as you show passing with an 80% or higher, you will show as passed in our system.

CANCELLATIONS:

- Payment is due before the course can be accessed and is non-refundable once the course has been accessed.

NOTES FOR STUDENTS:

- This course should be viewed using a Chrome browser. Any other browsers, such as Safari or Firefox, may cause glitches within the course.
- Each section contains reading text and an attached PowerPoint. Make sure to review all of the section's materials.
- You must pass each section's "self-check" quiz with a 100% to proceed to the next section.

- You must pass the final exam portion with an 80% or higher. You will have 2 attempts. After the 2 attempts, you must re-register and re-take the course.
- Once registered, the student will have 7 days to complete the course. This course can be started and stopped as many times that is needed within the 7 days.
- Once you have successfully completed the course, the certification is valid for 2 years.
