SEARCH & RESCUE OPEN ENROLLMENT

1 DAY/8 HOURS

This class covers the basic skills that a firefighter needs to function efficiently during interior search and rescue missions. This class emphasizes the basic functions of a search team in locating and removing victims. The course will cover techniques on how to perform a primary or secondary search in occupancies, as well as emergency procedures firefighters must initiate should they become separated from the search team or become disoriented.
