Subject: NICS Indices - MNU Field Character Length Update MKE/EDP, MKE/MDP, and MKE/SDP

Hello ACCESS Users,

On 9/10/2024, the following technical update will be made in Omnixx to the NICS Indices Entry (MKE/EDP), Modify (MKE/MDP), and Supplement (MKE/SDP) forms.

When is this happening?

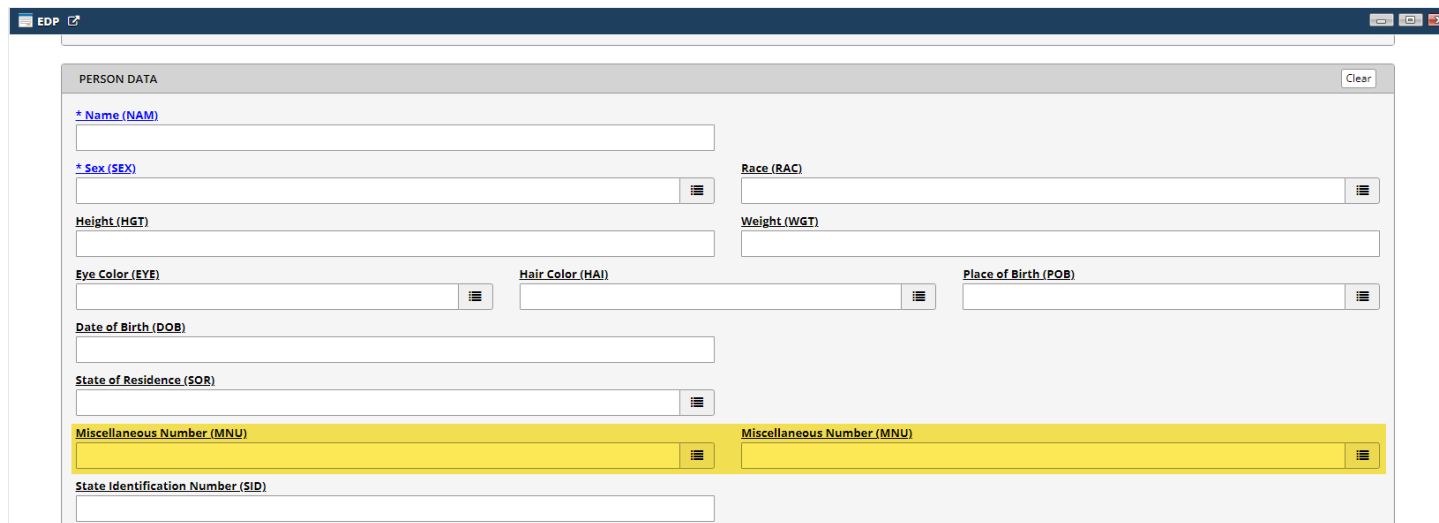
This is scheduled for the morning of 9/10/2024. You will not have to do anything for this update. This update is automatic in Omnixx the next time you login. You can also select “Reload” to update if you are already logged in.



What is changing?

The MNU Field will be modified to accept up to 30 characters to align with NICS. Previously the MNU Field allowed up to 15 characters in the EDP, MDP, and SDP forms.

This will only impact the following NICS Indices forms: MKE/EDP, MKE/MDP, and MKE/SDP. No other forms will be updated.
