Subject: Tribal Warrants Act – RCW 10.32

Good morning,

Due to the Tribal Warrants Act – RCW 10.32 – Effective July 1, 2025 all tribal warrants should now be entered into the wanted person file.

Where can I find more information on these changes?

Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1829 outlines the changes in addition to RCW 10.32 and 9A.72.010.

Next steps for your agency?

All non-extraditable tribal warrant entries in the person of interest file need to be removed from the system and re-entered into the wanted person file. This should be done no later than **July 31, 2025**.

Next steps for ACCESS?

On August 1, 2025 ACCESS will purge all non-extraditable tribal warrant entries in the person of interest file and start decommissioning the ability to enter “non-extraditable tribal warrants” in the person of interest file.
