



**Washington State Patrol
Firearms Background Check
Program - Annual Report**

July 2025

Executive Summary

Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5985 passed the 2024 legislative session, requiring the Washington State Patrol to report on the average time between receiving a background check request and final decision. This report is due annually, starting no later than July 1, 2025.

Background

The Washington State Patrol Firearms Background Division serves as the central point of contact for firearm dealers to conduct background checks related to firearm sales and transfers.

It uses the Secure Automated Firearms E-Check (SAFE) system for firearm background checks. This system, which became mandatory for all firearm dealers on January 1, 2024, determines whether a purchaser is legally eligible to own a firearm. The SAFE system interfaces with various databases, including those from the FBI, the Administrative Office of the Courts, and other state agencies.

Average Time

Average processing time is calculated by aggregating the durations of all background check cases, including those resolved through automated rule-based systems and those that undergo manual staff adjudication. The result is a composite measure of overall system performance.

* In November 2024, a two-week outage at the Administrative Office of the Courts significantly increased our average processing time.

Yearly Average Time**

The average time required for a human examiner to fully adjudicate a background check was **80.85 hours** or approximately **3.3 days**.

In contrast, background checks processed through rule-based automation averaged **2.6 hours**, with automatic denials occurring in **under 3 minutes**.

** The November 2024 average was excluded from the annual calculation to provide a more accurate reflection of typical processing times.
