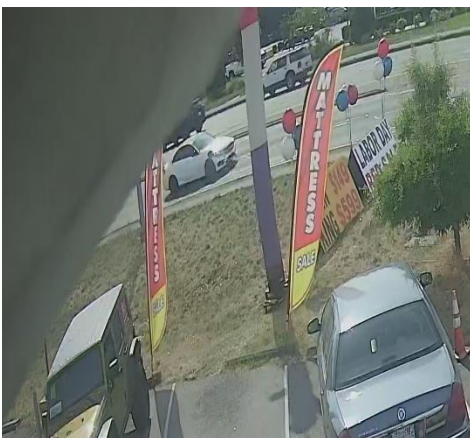

WSP Needs Assistance Identifying Hit and Run Suspect

Puyallup, Wash. – After 3p.m. on Saturday, August 30th 2025, on Meridian Avenue (State Route 161) and 168th Street East, a pedestrian on a bicycle was hit by a white Mercedes C-Class sedan and suffered severe injuries.

After striking the pedestrian, the Mercedes sedan fled the scene. The suspect vehicle was described as having tinted windows, tinted taillights, and black rims. The pedestrian possessed a purse-like bag that became stuck to the front right fender of the Mercedes following the impact. Please reference the photographs below.
