- 3. A WASHINGTON STATE PATROL INSPECTION REQUEST ISSUED BY A WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AGENT.
- 4. A WASHINGTON STATE TRANSIT PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO OPERATE THE VEHICLE ON WASHINGTON STATE ROADS. THE TRANSIT PERMIT CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY LICENSING AGENT.
