## **Detectives Seeking Witnesses To A Fatal Hit And Run**

**King County:** Last night, September 13, 2025, at approximately 11:40pm, Washington State Patrol (WSP) communications received 9-1-1 calls reporting a serious collision SB SR 509 near Meyers Way.

Once troopers arrived, they determined this was a two car, one motorcycle collision and the motorcycle rider was unfortunately deceased.

Further details revealed that a white passenger car was driving erratically and struck the motorcycle dislodging the rider. A gray vehicle subsequently struck the motorcycle. The causing vehicle fled the scene exiting to Meyers Way.

Parts from the suspect vehicle were left at the scene. It appears that the bumper of this vehicle was metallic blue painted white. The vehicle will have front and rear end damage.
